OUTCOME: The performance of the student was discussed and the personal as well as academic problems of the student were discussed jointly and efforts were made to solve these problems.



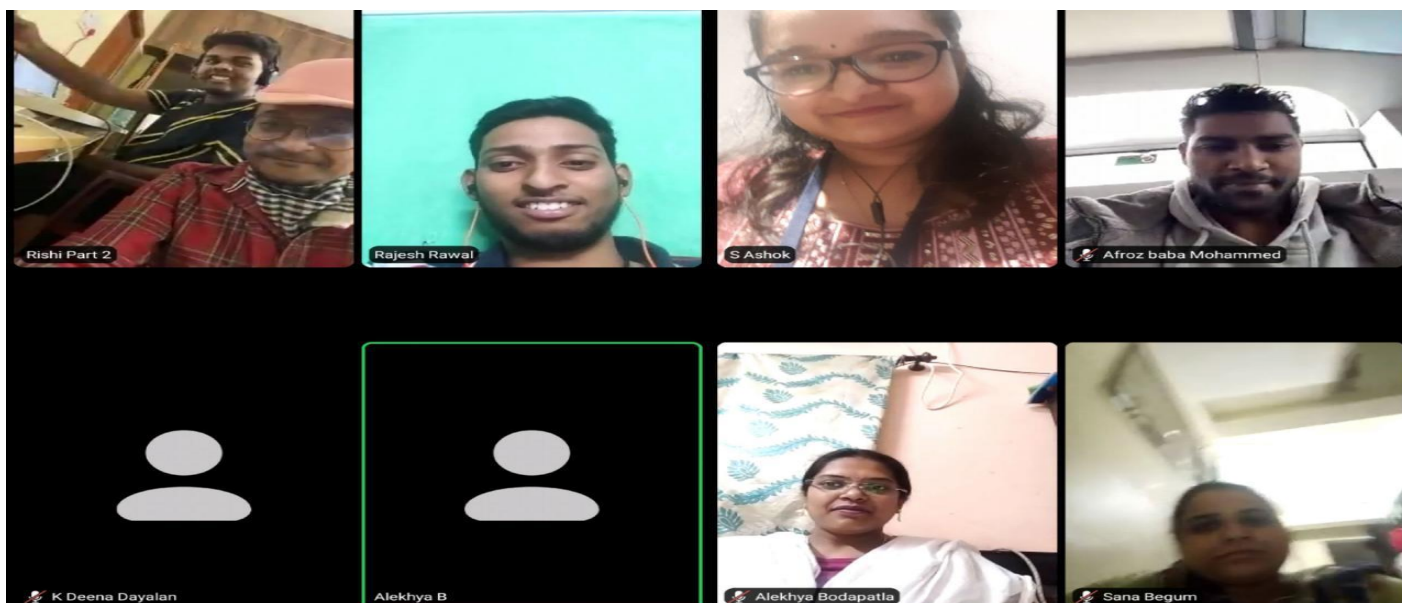
ONLINE ALUMNI MEET 2021-22
