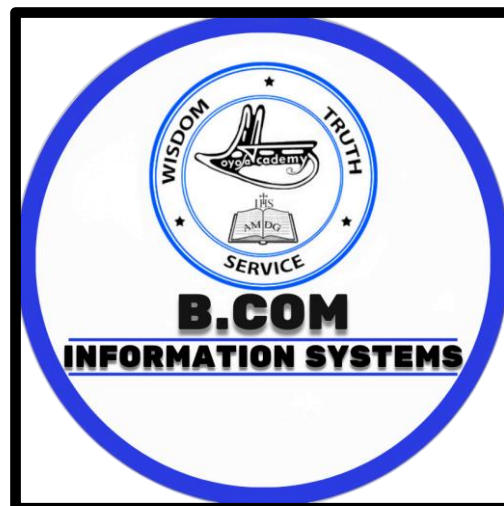

PURPOSE:

1. To interact with the students with actual industry personnel.
2. To make students aware of industrial procedures required to enter in any company.
3. To experience the working environment in industry.
4. Interaction of students with the people of all important departments.

ABOUT THE TRIP:

The B.Com. Information Systems department of Loyola Academy, Hyderabad, organized an industrial trip to Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Private Limited, located in Miyapur, Hyderabad, on 27th February 2023. The students were accompanied by the department lecturers Mr. Parvathagari Rajkumar Reddy and Mrs. K. Aparna.

The students arrived at the Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Private Limited facility. The company welcomed us by showing a Thank You video and giving us some instructions about the factory. After that, we were requested to sit in the guest room, where we were given a large introduction and history of the company, its sales margins, production targets, and other relevant information. The company provided us with refreshments, which were on the house. During the tour, we had a guide who was with us throughout the factory and its departments. We visited many units and departments, including the production line, bottling line, quality control labs, and packaging area.



The guide provided us with detailed information on the production process and how the company maintains its high-quality standards. The students were given the opportunity to ask questions related to the production process and quality control, which were answered by the guide. We also had a chance to observe the different stages of the production process and see how the raw materials were transformed into finished products. It spans over 25 acres and has a production capacity of over 600 bottles per minute.

The company uses state-of-the-art technology and equipment to ensure quality and consistency in their products. We were shown the laboratory where samples are tested and analyzed to ensure that they meet the company's standards. The company is committed to sustainability and has implemented several initiatives to reduce their environmental impact.



STAGE 1: A large introduction and history of the company, its sales margins, production targets, and other relevant information.

STAGE 2: We visited many units and departments, including the production line, bottling line, quality control labs, and packaging area.

STAGE 3: To observe the different stages of the production process and see how the raw materials were transformed into finished products.

STAGE 4: We were shown the waste management system and the wastewater treatment plant, which uses a process called reverse osmosis to treat the water and make it safe for discharge.

OUTCOME:

Students completed the visit with lots of knowledge about the manufacturing process of different companies.

BRIDGE COURSE

FUNDAMENTALS OF ACCOUNTING

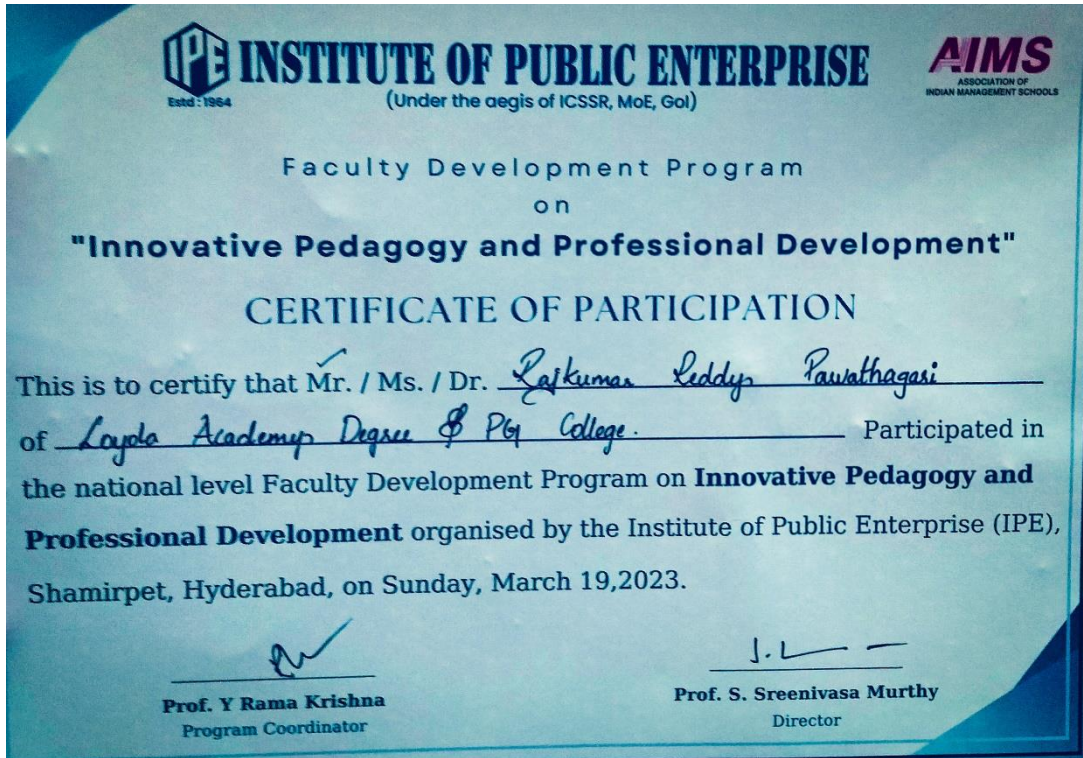
