# **INDUSTRIAL TRIP TO GAYATRI SUGARS LTD.**

## **Purpose:**

To help students in gaining knowledge on process based industry ,their costing functions.

## **Review:**

The factory runs only six months a year and is cleaned in other six months .

On the educational side, the students gained information on what were the various steps involved in the sugar making procedure, joint products and by products.

## **Report:**

On 13<sup>th</sup> February 2019 the students of B.Com Honours Strategic Finance from Loyola Degree and PG College were taken for an industrial trip to Kamareddy to visit a sugar industry.

Gayatri sugars welcomes everyone who wants to visit by leading them to a field filled with sugarcane stock which they get from the farmers freshly on a daily basis, the stock sums up to 3700 tons approximately.

All this stock is moved on to an base just outside the factory's main entrance ,from which giant clamper like machines pick up the stock and take them to the main machine which is used to separate the sugarcane juice and its waste.

Material will be issued on FIFO (First in first out) method.

Once separated the juice is sent to a different part of the factory for further processing. The waste i.e. husk is sent into two boilers to generate electricity which is both used by the company and is also distributed to whole of Kamareddy. It is a self-sustaining factory uses this electricity ( 6 loads) is used to

power the turbines which pushes all the sugarcane juice towards processing. This is a huge part of the factory, with a gigantic machine which has the capacity to produce 4000 tonnes of sugar and 500 tonnes of Jaggery. All this processed material is pack and stored in warehouses which are just few steps away from the processing unit. This factory is manned by a headcount of 300 labourers. The factory only runs for six months as sugarcane is cultivated only for only six months a year. The waste obtained by processing the sugar is called molasses. Unprocessed sugarcane juice is used to produce alcohol is sent to the alcohol factory right in the premises.
