

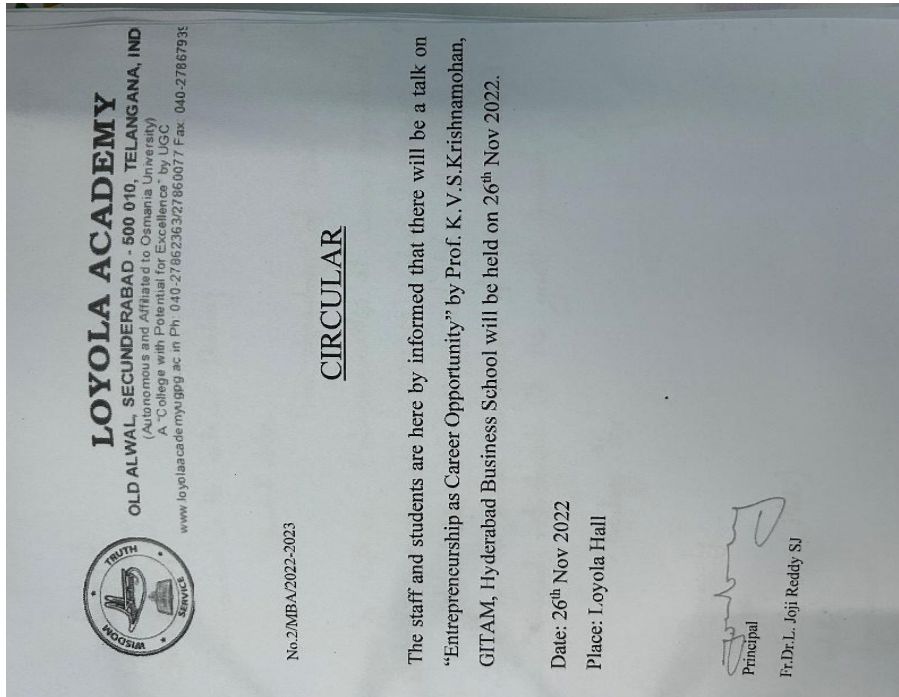

REPORT TALK ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP – AS A CAREER OPPORTUNITY

The department of Master of Business Administration (MBA) had organized a talk on Entrepreneurship on 26th November, 2022 for the students of I & II year MBA students and faculty members at Loyola Hall providing them guidance on how entrepreneurship can be pursued as a successful career. which was addressed by Mr. K V S Krishnamohan, Professor at GITAM Business School, Hyderabad.



Professor Krishnamohan initiated the session by making all the students log into Menti.com, a website that would help him gain an insight on the student perception on what their career

path and choices. He focused on how various start-ups such as Zomato, Oyo and TATA were formed and what it took from the entrepreneurs to establish their businesses. He also spoke about how an entrepreneurial idea can emerge out of everyday common things given the right mind-set. Further he proceeded to brief on the three main elements of investment, which are ‘time, money and energy’, and also stated that one does not have to wait till the completion of their education to pursue their own ventures in business. He explained that concept with the example of “MBA Chaiwala” to emphasis on the business. He mentioned some books like “Rich dad, Poor dad” for financial assistance, “wings of fire” for inspiration and “Stay hungry, stay foolish” to find a career path.



He gave his valuable input by sharing a personal experience of an OLA driver, how the driver was a fulltime student and still drove a car in his free time in order to fulfil his desire to drive and pay off the debt for his car. He also shared a story that he came across from his colleague from another institution where the students took an initiative to hold “birthday celebration services” where they would be in charge of arranging and preparing for various activities related to birthdays. When asked by a student on what would be an appropriate time to consider starting their own ventures, he assured the students are never too late to start by giving the example of Colonel Sander, who is the founder of KFC. He spoke about how important it is to use resources efficiently and effective so as to avoid loss and wastage to improve on outputs.



Briefing in depth he highlighted on two start-ups in India, “Mirakle Couriers” and “Good Fellow”. Mirakle Couriers started in 2009, located in Mumbai which hires deaf and mute workers as their employees and good fellow is a programme which cares for Old Aged individuals, and Prof. elaborated as it is a good venture as “India itself is gradually becoming and old age home, as most of its youngsters are moving abroad and becoming NRI (Non-Returning Indians).”




He concluded the session by displaying two videos, one which was a news report on the ‘good fellow’ programme in which Mr Ratan Tata invested. He ended the session with a countdown on the 7 youngest entrepreneurs in India. At the end of the talk, he also interacted with students from the audience and the student volunteers and gave various insights on how

learning can be more effective on the part of students and how they need to focus on building their skills and being creative at learning things to understand and remember them in a better way.

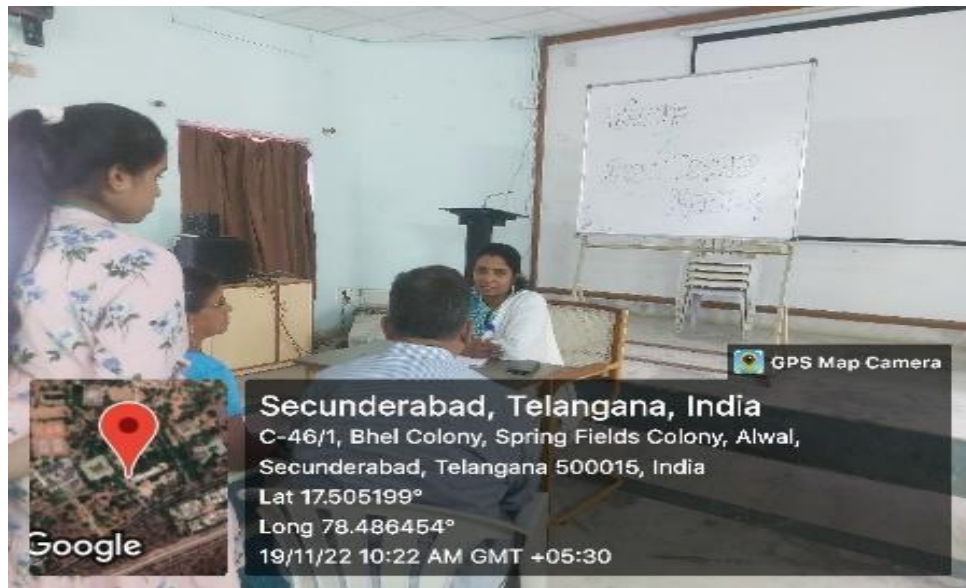
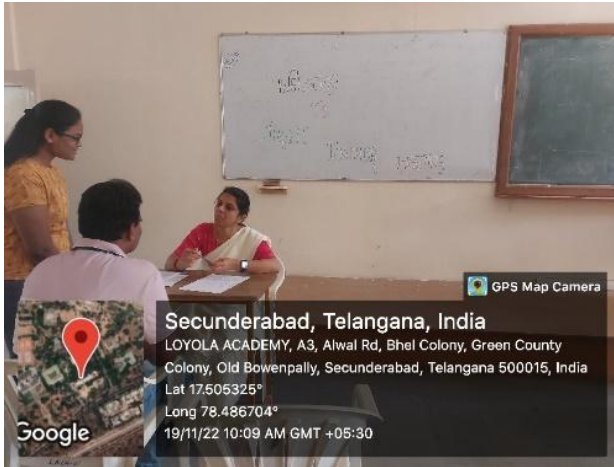

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARENESS
A Visit to Sivananda Rehabilitation Home

Place : Kukatpally

Date : 19 Nov' 2022.

Sivananda Rehabilitation Home (SRH) was founded as a charitable institution in 1958 by Rani Kumudini Devi in Hyderabad, Telangana, India to serve the needs of people affected by leprosy. Since its founding, SRH has grown into a large well-known institute housing more than 300 patients. The mission of the home is to prevent disability, provide adequate medical care to destitute patients with leprosy and tuberculosis, as well as to reduce the occurrence of new cases through community education.





The Planet organized by the Department of MBA gave the students an enlightening and learning experience. As the first-year students of AMBA (sec -A) have visited Sivananda rehabilitation home today where students have interacted with those affected with leprosy and cancer. We learnt about the care given to them and its diagnosis. We also got the opportunity to visit and interact with the elderly aged and witness the craft of handloom weavers. Report on CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOP HELD AT LOYOLA ACADEMY, SECUNDERABAD.

A Capacity building workshop organised by the school of business management and placement cell for three days (3rd,4th,5th November 2022) at Loyola hall, to enhance the skills of MBA students. The workshop heads Dr.T Rachel shalini (Dean of school of management), Ms.Deepthi (Placement officer) and Dr.Smitha (Faculty In-charge) administrated the workshop. DAY 1 (3rd Nov 2022). Morning session Mr. Harshavardhana Rao was the resource person invited to grace the workshop. The programme was started with a welcome speech by Dr.T Rachel shalini, Dean of school of management. REV Fr Joseph kumar, vice principal addressed the gathering and described the importance of developing the skills. The main aim for the workshop was to introduce new ideas, inspire the students to further explore it on their own. Some of the key points which we have discussed were as follows ➤ The first discussion was about the communication skills development. The trainer told how to develop the skills and explained about how to overcome stage fear. His message was “Always be confident about yourself and what you are talking” ➤ After that he clearly depicted about the Industry trends of 2022. They are as follows • Industry Cloud and Public Cloud • Crypto Currency • Artificial Intelligence • Chat bots • Mixed Reality and Meta verse • Digital twins • 5G • Carbon Capture • Human Resources ➤ Next topic is about the various departments in an industry like • Sales • Finance • Marketing ➤ After that he explained about the Corporate Expectations like • Flexibility • Creativity • Open to learn new things • Initiative and Motivation • Able to work in a team • Organisation • Strong work ethics • Analytical skills • Computer Technology • Written and Oral Communication. Afternoon session: After the small break, the discussion was about ➤ How to prepare for an Interview. The key points are as follows • Research the company • Learn everything you can about the open position • Try out the company’s product or service • Be confident on yourself • Prepare a reference list ➤ Next topic was about the various social media apps which provides the job for a freshers. The apps are Linkdin, Jobmela, Youtube, Instagram. ➤ Then we discussed about the Grooming in a workplace. • Gain not just a positive impression but also respect in the workplace • Always follow policies and code of conduct • Avoid using sign language • Be honest if you don’t know the answer ➤ Then explained how to write a Resume and gave some points • Outlining your relevant experience and skills • Showcasing the benefits you provide to companies • Attracting the attention of potential • It should match you and your skills • This could leads to an interview ➤ At last, concluded with the points discussed in both the session.

DAY 2 Morning Session The session commenced with welcoming the Speaker Mr.Harshavardhana Rao at 9:30 AM. Two sessions were planned for the day. The main aim

of day 2 , session was to prepare the students to face the interviews confidently. Morning session was about the Resume writing. Key points about the resume were discussed. These points are important to increase the candidates impression in front of the recruiter as, it was discussed yesterday's that, resume needs to speak for the one who applied for the position. The skills mentioned in the resume needs to be so clear and must be favorable both the recruiter and candidate. The candidate should be able to lead the interview as this would let them show their best skills in their domain and highlight the reason why they are the best for the position. It was mentioned that, when Radio buttons and percentages are mentioned one must exactly explain the reason. The basic difference between CV and resume was clarified. There is a little difference between the both. Before, CV consists of more than 2 pages which is used to be a very detailed information about the candidate whereas resume used to be a simple format of 1 or 2 page which basically explain about the skills of the candidate Afternoon session was all about group discussion. Topics like, "Impact of COVID-19 on global economy, OTT vs Theatres, importance of netiquette, hike in fuel prices". Topics were discussed. Each discussion had their own uniqueness and highlighted various points that would be generally missed in a group discussion. The main aim of these discussions was to correct our stand during the discussion and learn how to behave during a group discussion. The rest of the members acted as spectators to observe and notice what are the most common mistakes done in group discussions. The session concluded with a brief towards interview etiquette and body language of an interviewee. A lot of information that would be useful in helping a candidate stand out in interviews was acquired through the activities carried out for the day. The session was pretty well planned and informative.

DAY 3 Morning session Key tips were regarding, HOW TO ATTEND AN INTERVIEW?,HOW TO GROOM ONESELF FOR AN INTERVIEW? and HOW TO BEHAVE IN AN INTERVIEW ROOM? These Were clearly explained by the Speaker and later he introduced Mr.Rajesh Rao who is the senior most employee in his firm, a trainer(He trained many young talents pertaining personality development and also conducted many workshops which helps the students to choose the right career path). This session was about Do's and Don'ts for an interview i.e, to "maintain Punctuality, be prepared with a resume which is suitable to the job title applied for, be prepared for the interview mentally and physically and research about the company. Do not attend for an interview without preparation, don't be emotional if the interviewer tries to stress hard", all these things make an individual to improve oneself in those areas in which he/she is lacking. How to behave in a physical or virtual Interview? What are the main things to be done after the interview are, like calling the coordinator and showing the gratitude for that opportunity given. One should proceed with a positive attitude though he/she is not selected too. He/she should be grateful for the new things learnt even from the mistakes and focus on the points that are to be

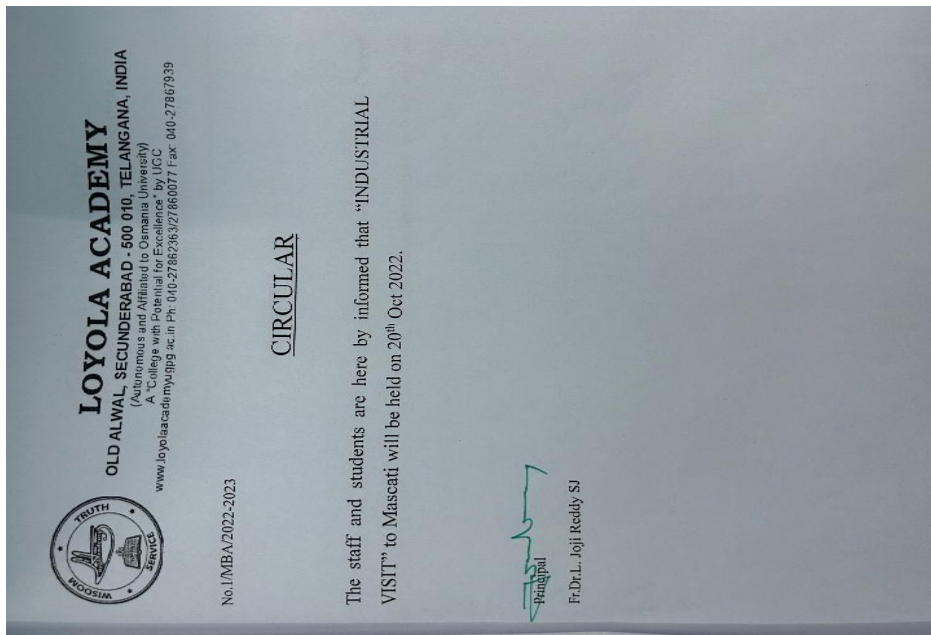
improved. Afternoon session This session was about taking mock interviews for the students and evaluating their performances. One should know the basic principles before attending an interview. Communication, body language, subject knowledge, presence of mind and grooming are the main principles that are to be kept in mind. Conducted mock interviews for the students to give an idea on how to face the Interview, to accustom them to the different interview environments and enhance their self-confidence so that they will less likely to be nervous during the real interview further. Additionally, mock interviews will familiarize one with commonly asked interview questions. The session concluded with small act on role play between HR department and Technical department on the recruitment strategy and ended with vote of thanks.

Industrial Visit Report

Date: 20th October, 2022

Place: Masquati, Turkayamjal

No.of Participants: 130



The Department of Business Administration – MBA had organized an Industrial visit to Masqati Dairy Production unit located in Turkayamjal on 20th October, 2022 for the 2nd year students. Masqati is a local dairy production company which was started by **Ibrahim Bin Abdullah Masqati** in the year 1965 it currently operates in two states – Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. The company is into production of Cow & Buffalo milk, Curd, Paneer, Ghee, Ice cream and Flavoured milk. After arriving at the industry, the students were segregated into two separate groups with one group being guided by Mr. Shekhar, Quality Control Manager and another group being guided by Mr. Syed Mubashir Shiek, Quality Control Executive.

As the students were taken for a tour of the factory, we were explained how various production processes take place simultaneously in the factory. The initial production process begins with sourcing of milk that is done through farms owned by the company. Every day around 2 lakh litres of milk come from the farm which is first tested and stored. It is later sent for pasteurization and homogenised. After these processes are complete it is sent for packing. Every minute of the production process 36 packets of milk are produced and packed. Cream that is obtained after pasteurization is churned into butter which is further heated to make ghee. The company produces three types of ghee which include;

- a) Yellow that is Cow ghee
- b) White that is Buffalo ghee
- c) Half boiled Buffalo ghee

The ghee is stored in steel containers (each with a capacity of 1500kg) and is later sent for packaging. For Badam milk, almonds are soaked and peeled while milk is boiled at 120-degree Celsius for 35 minutes and when it comes down to room temperature almonds are added to it. Every day an approximate of 65 kgs of almonds are used for the production of badam milk by the company. The company also offers flavoured milk which includes chocolate and strawberry. For the production of curd, milk is first packed into curb containers and is sent for bacterial fermentation which forms curd. The company also produces ice creams and have a variety of 52 flavours of ice creams. The company has various cold storage units for each product with different temperature rooms and specifications.



The factory unit is spread across 17 acres and has around 1500 workers and employees working in the production unit.

Problem identification:

1. The initial problem that was identified is that there was lack of adequate sanitisation in the production unit as certain places of the production unit had foul odour.

2. The second problem was with waste disposal at the ice cream production unit where the wastage of fruits was not being disposed off immediately while the production of ice cream was taking place right beside it.
3. With a big number of workers working in the production unit, the residential facility provided to them was not adequate enough.



Outcome of the industrial visit: The students had a very fruitful outcome as they were exposed to a practical experience of how production takes place in a production unit helping

them relate their theoretical knowledge with practical experience. As the students had already studied subjects specific to productions and operations management which also included quality control, this trip helped them understand how all these processes are planned, organized, and executed in real life. Faculty members and students at the production unit. We are thankful to our HOD, Dr. Lavanya and to all our faculty members for providing us this opportunity.

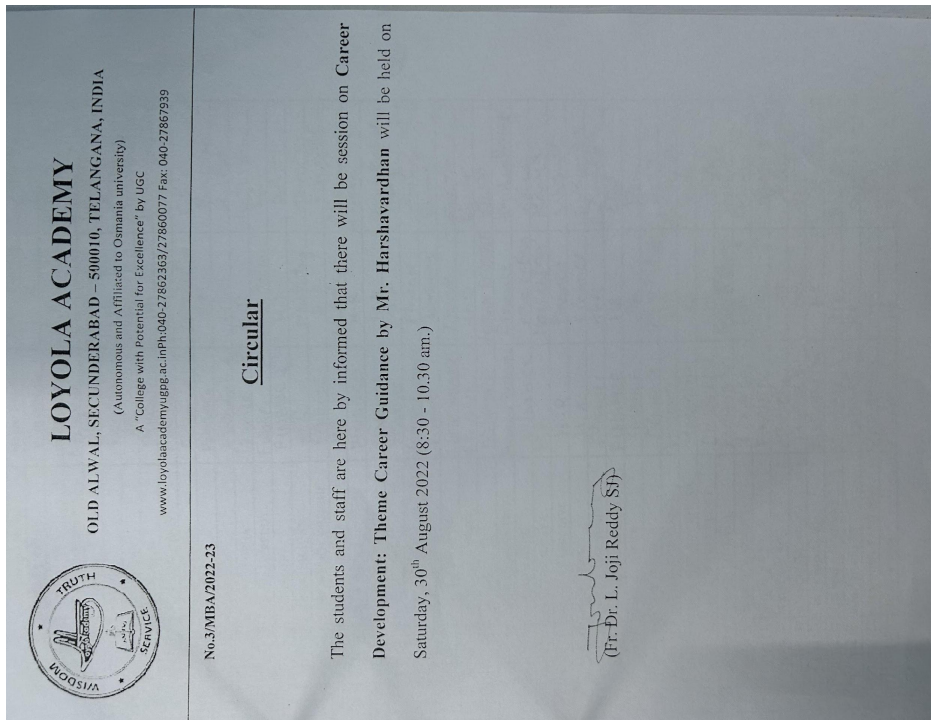

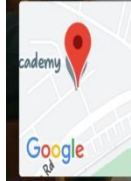
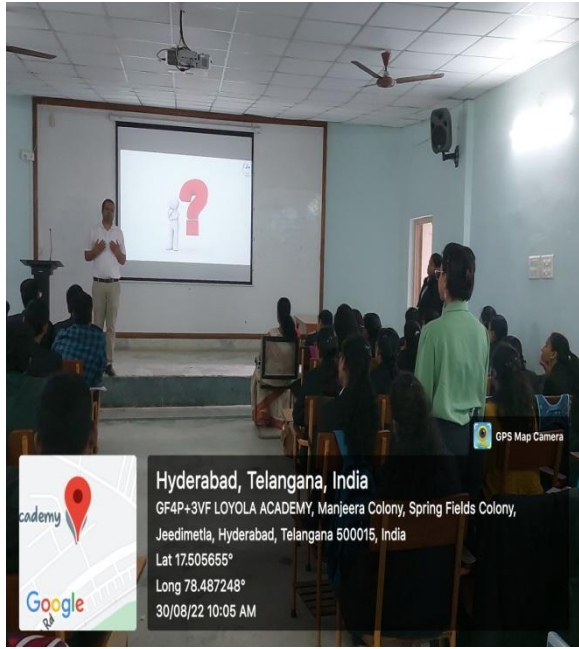
speaker and audiences. A brief introduction about Mr. Harshasvardhan, was given by a student of MBA, Mr. Harshasvardhan shared his experiences.
