Usha Rani ma'am is the organiser of Sannihitha homes. Mary Jones ma'am, Krishna Kumari Ma'am are the Program organizers. They shared their experience about the wellness and well being of the children and the whole community, their presence made the event more successful.

We have arrived at the location by 2:30Pm and program was held upto 5:00Pm. We have started the program by giving a short introduction about our major concern and the reason why we were visiting the campus.

In order to cheerup and build rapport with those children, we conducted a small fun game called ice breaker.



The game was adjoined by a skit presented by a group of our classmates which was related to create awareness about “Healthy eating choices and avoiding junk food “.



We then conducted a few basic exercises to state awareness about importance of physical activity .

After these activities, children were divided into groups and each of our classmates personally counselled each group about nutritional intake , healthy habits ,morals and ethics. This conversation was hoped to bring up a great impact on children.

Note:

- This electronically generated Score Card is the official result declared by NTA and does not require any signature.
- Candidate's particulars including Category and Person with Disability (PwD) have been indicated as mentioned by the candidate in the online Application Form.
- Subject wise Cut-Off is based on the Percentage of Marks Obtained.
- Those qualified for Assistant Professor will not be considered for award of JRF. Candidates who qualify the Test for eligibility for Assistant Professor will be governed by the rules and regulations for recruitment of Assistant Professor of the concerned universities/colleges/State governments, as the case may be.
- The slots of JRFs of both UGC-NET December 2020 and June 2021 cycles have been merged, while the methodology for Subject wise crm. Category wise allocation of JRFs remains unchanged.
- The candidates who qualify for the award of Junior Research Fellowship are eligible to pursue research in the subject of their post-graduation or in a related subject and are also eligible for Assistant Professor. The universities, institutions, IITs and other national organizations may select the JRF awardees for full time research work in accordance with the procedure prescribed by them.
- Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Scheduled Caste(SC)/Scheduled Tribe(ST)/Persons with Disability(PwD)/ Thirdgender /Other Backward Classes -Non creamy layer (OBC-NCL), as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, candidate will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the UGC.
- Candidates qualifying for the award of Junior Research fellowship will be eligible to receive fellowship of UGC under various schemes, subject to their finding placement in universities/IITs/institutions. The validity period of the offer is three years w.e.f. the date of issue of JRF Award Letter. However, in case the candidates who have already joined M. Phil. / Ph.D., the date of commencement of fellowship shall be from the date of declaration of NET result or date of their joining, whichever is later.
- The National Testing Agency shall not be responsible for any printing error in the publication. While preparing the scores due care has been taken. However, any inadvertent error cannot be ruled out. The NTA reserves the right to rectify any error at a later stage.
- No separate intimation letter shall be issued.
