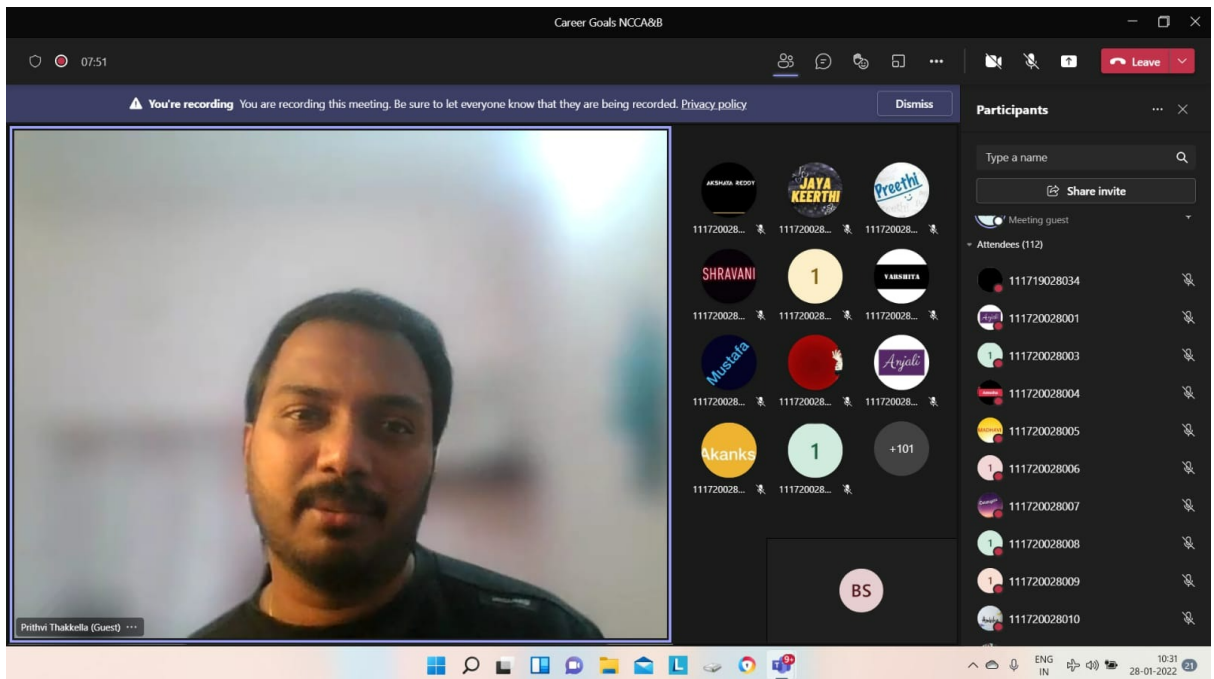
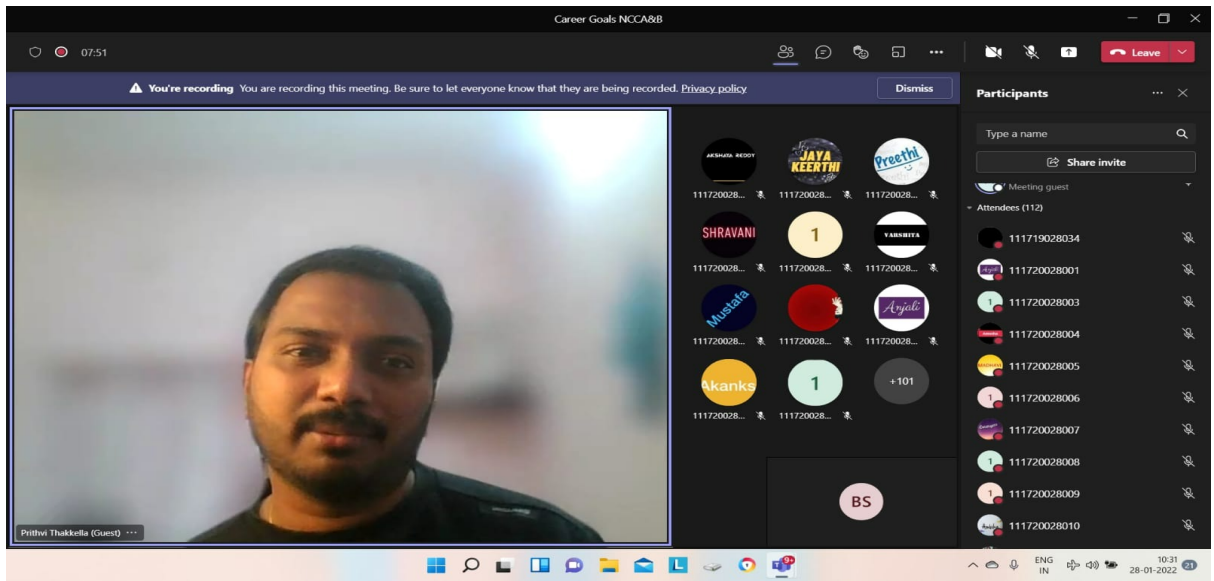
Report about the session conducted

Arduino is **an open-source electronics platform based on easy-to-use hardware and software**. Arduino boards are able to read inputs - light on a sensor, a finger on a button, or a Twitter message - and turn it into an output - activating a motor, turning on an LED, publishing something online.

Today Arduino is **used for the control of traffic lights; it can also be used for the real time control system with programmable timings, pedestrian lighting etc.**
