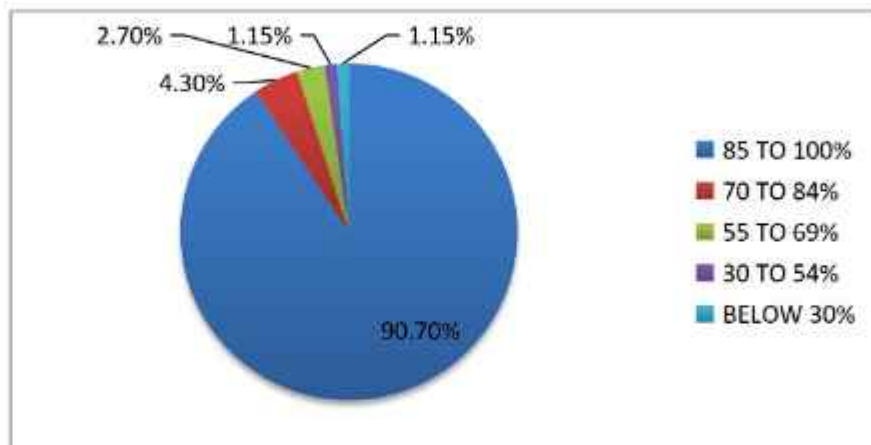


## Analysis of Students Satisfaction

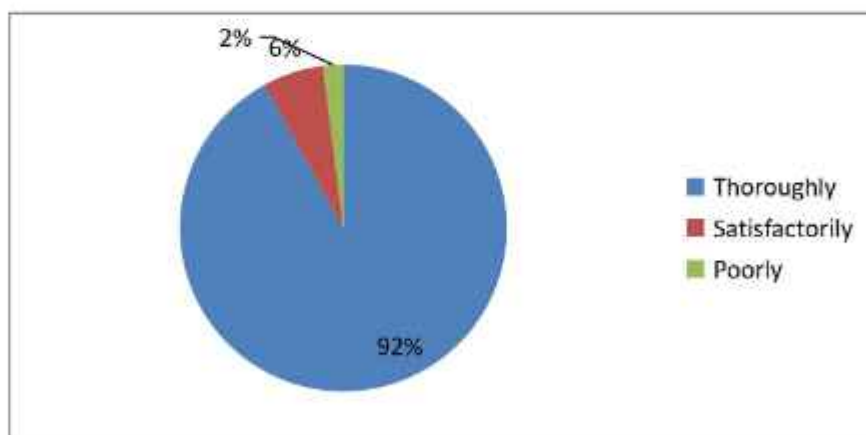
### Survey on TLP (22-23)

#### 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



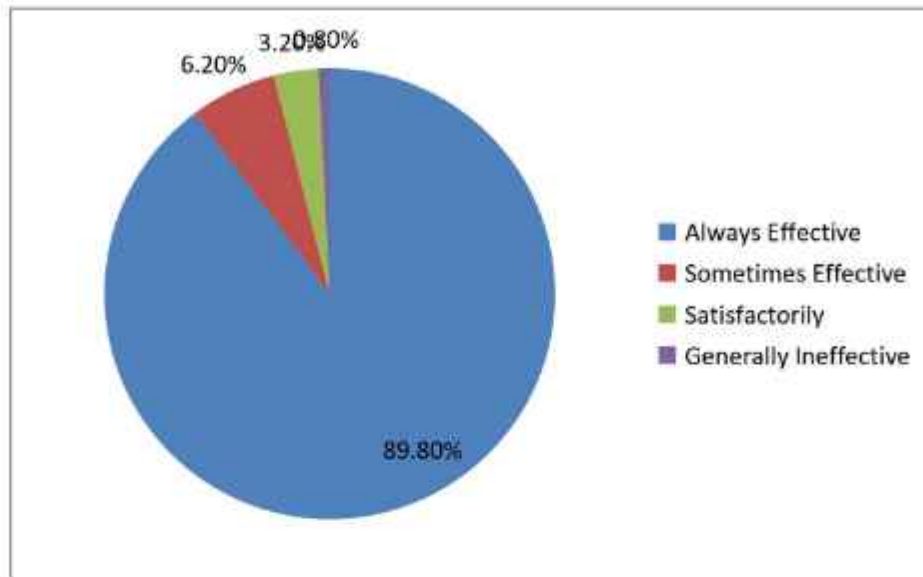

#### 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



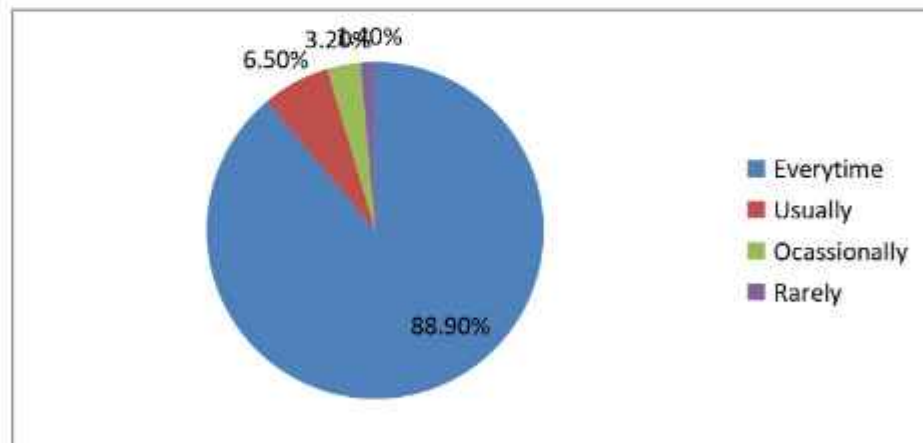
**Analysis:** The above analysis represents that 92% teachers prepare thoroughly for the class.

### 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



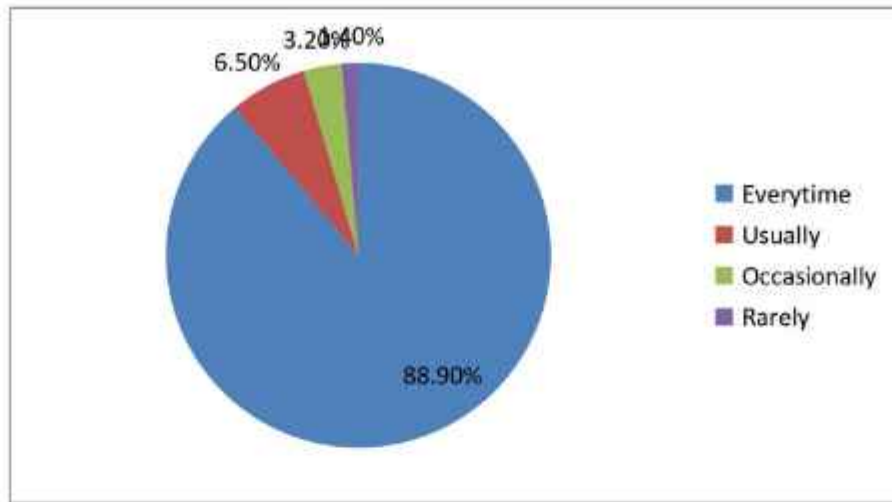
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 89.80% students noticed that teachers are always effective in communication.

### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as\*



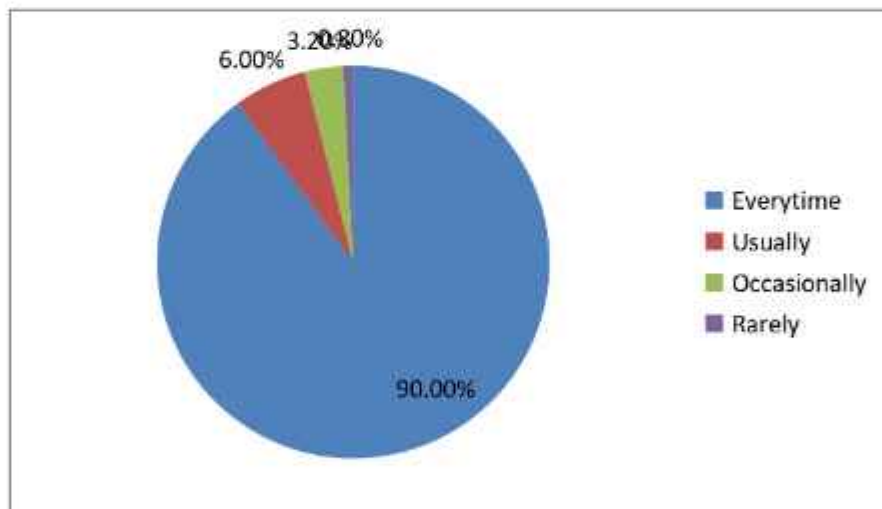
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 88.90% students observed that teaching approach of teachers is excellent.

### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.\*



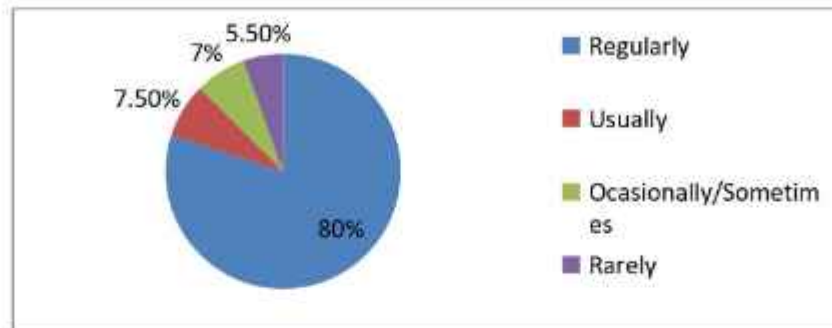
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 88.90% students think that internal evaluation process by the teachers is fair every time.

#### 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



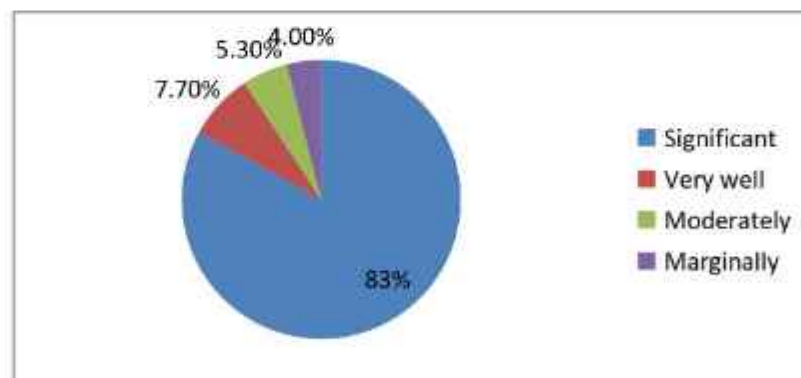
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 90% students noticed that teachers discuss their performance every time.

**7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.**



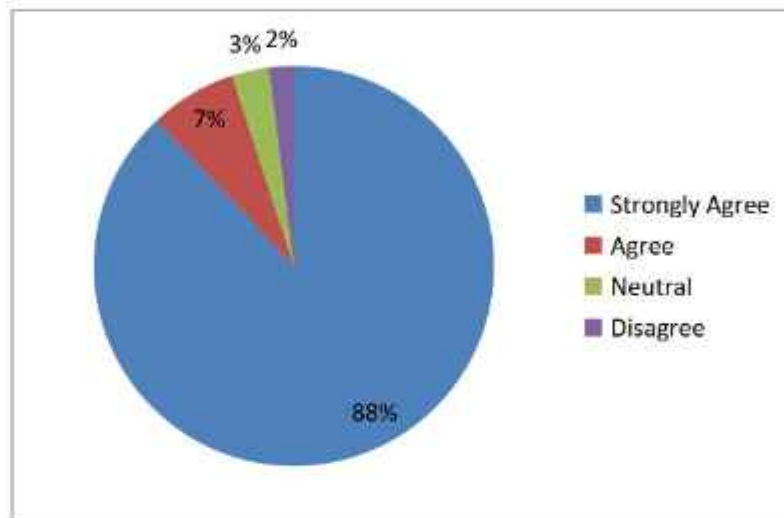
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 80% students noticed that institute regularly takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

**8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.**



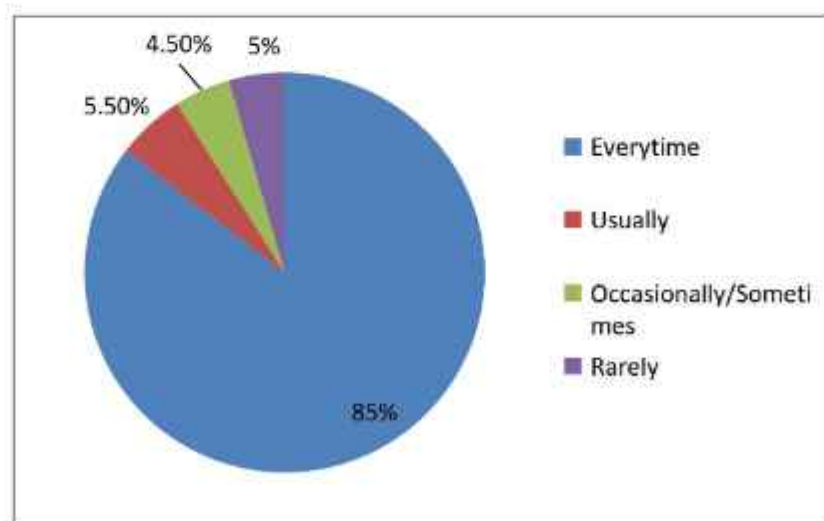
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 83% students observed that the teaching and mentoring process of institute is very effective in facilitating cognitive, social and emotional growth.

**9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.**



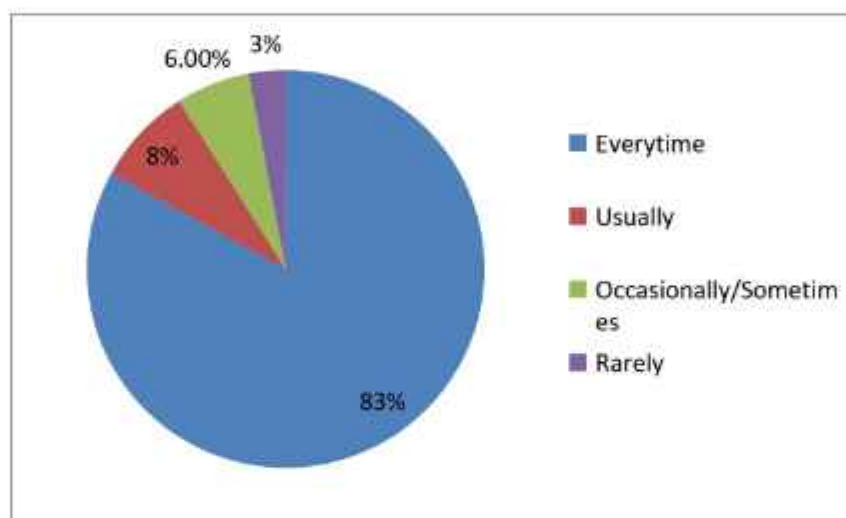
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 88% students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

**10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes**



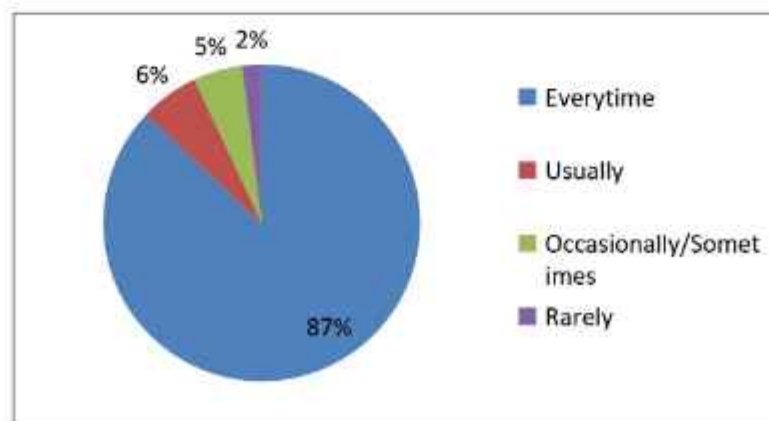
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 85% students observed that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

**11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you**



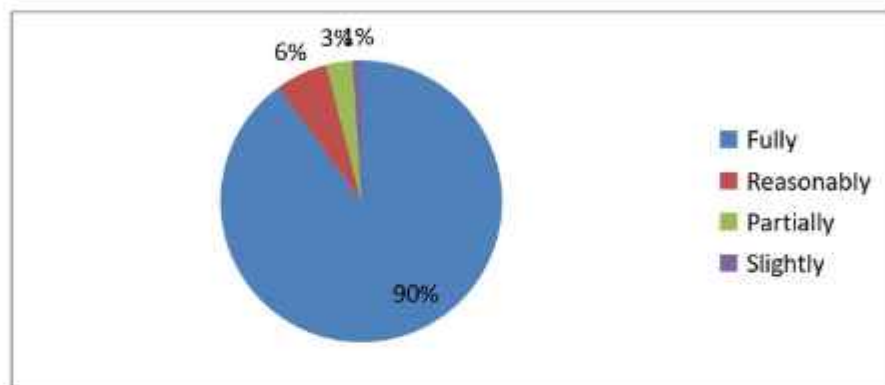
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 83% students noticed that their mentor does necessary follow-up for assigned task every time.

**12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.**



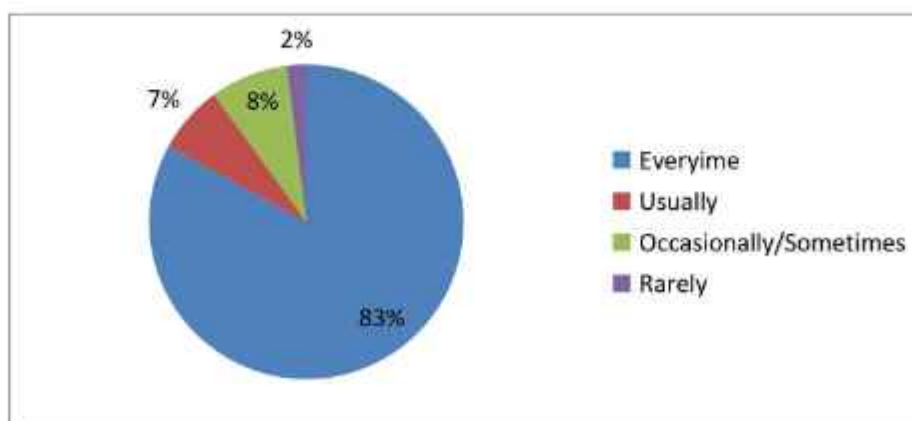
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 87% students observed that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications in the classroom every time.

**13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.**



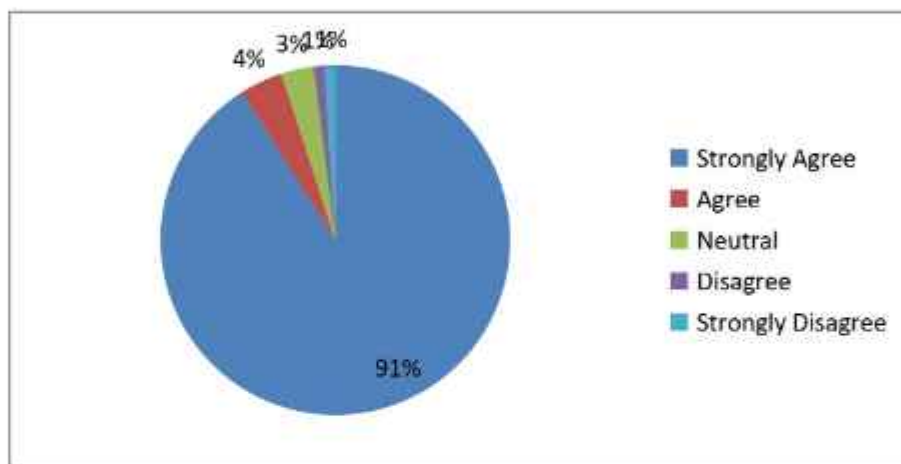
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 90% students noticed that teachers fully/ reasonably identify the strengths of students and try to encourage the students by providing right level of challenges.

**14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them**



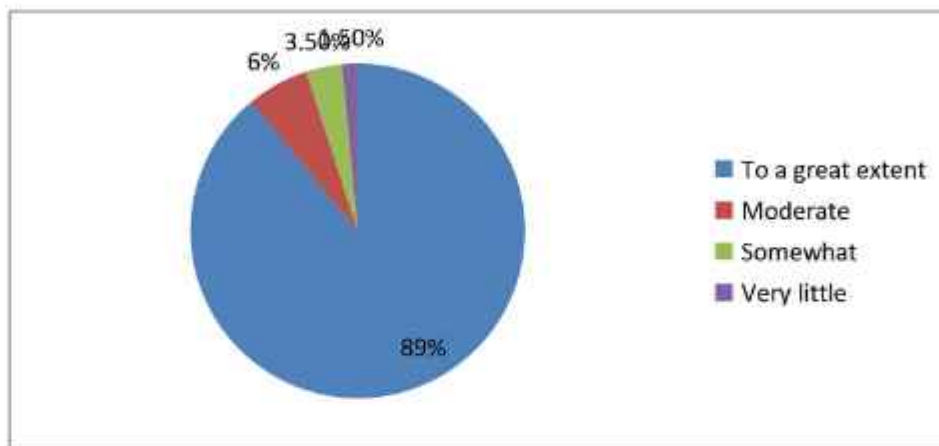
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 83.00% students noticed that teachers are able to identify the weaknesses of the students and help them to overcome the weakness every time

**15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.**



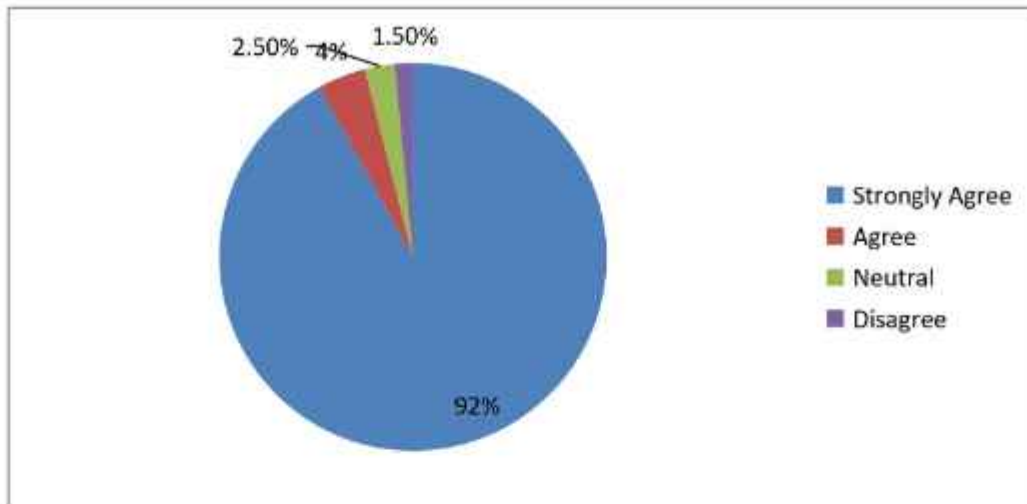

**16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.**



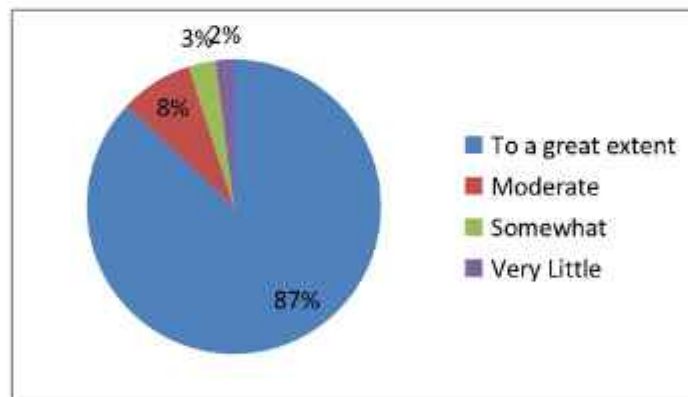

**17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.**



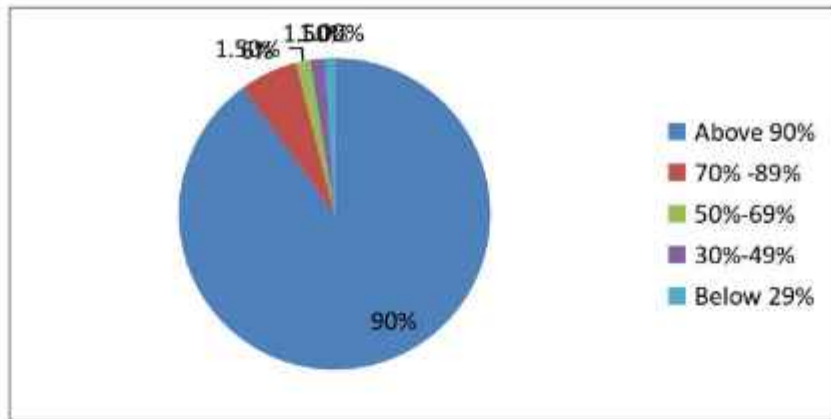
**Analysis:** From the above analysis, 92% students strongly agree that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.

**18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.**



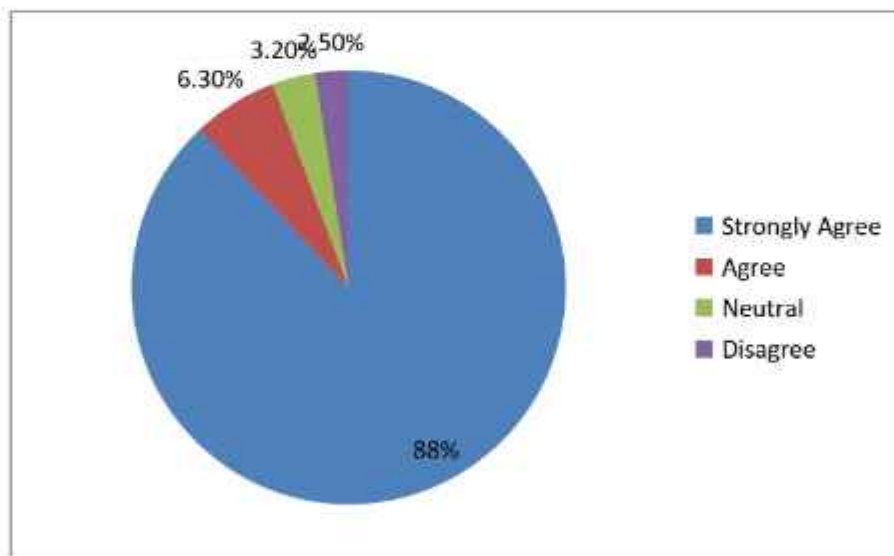
