



THE INSTITUTIONAL STRATEGIC/ PERSPECTIVE PLAN - IMPLEMENTED

The meeting of Governing Body members of Loyola Academy was held on Wednesday, 1st June 2022 at 10.30 a.m. onwards in the College Boardroom.

The following resolutions/changes were implemented:


- All the resolutions for B.Sc., B.A., B.Com., B.B.A. and PG programs were implemented.
- Three UG programs were started with six semesters namely
B.Sc. (Computer Science & Cloud Computing)
B.Sc. (Computer Science & Internet of Things)
B.B.A. (Retail Operations Management)
- The MBA enrollment was increased from 120 to 180 students (by adding one more section).
- The change in nomenclature of section B of BBA to BBA (Entrepreneurship Development), B.Com. (Computer Applications) to B.Com. (Information Systems) and the existing name of B.Sc. (Computer Systems & Engineering) to B.Sc. (Computer Science & Information Technology) These above-mentioned modifications were carried out.
- The amount allotted for
 - ✓ Library Rs.20,00,000/- (twenty lakhs only)
 - ✓ Laboratory Rs.20,00,000/- (twenty lakhs only) was spent.
- Four international inter disciplinary seminars / conferences in UG & PG in collaboration with IQAC were conducted.
- Staff were given incentives for their publications.
- New Staff were recruited as per the requirements of the concerned departments.
- A Concession in attendance for the students who are preparing for competitive exams (CA, Group exams etc.) up to 25 percent was not considered.
- A Beginner level course in Computers was conducted for students in orphanages.
- A Course in the Repair & Maintenance of Home Appliances for Neighbourhood students (economically backward) could not commence due to schedule constraints.
- Because the panel interview was postponed, the training of the NCC coordinators, Mr. Dheeraj Sahu and Mrs. V. Sirisha, was not carried out.
- Incubation centres were established by the college.

- Upgrading Biotechnology laboratory as a Research Centre is pending at Osmania University.
- The twinning program in collaboration with Pondicherry University has commenced (Already inspected by university in 2021-22).
- Instituting Schools for all common programs were implemented.
 - a) School of Agriculture
 - b) School of Sciences
 - c) School of Food Technology & Nutrition
 - d) School of Informatics
 - e) School of Commerce
 - f) School of Arts & Humanities
 - g) School of Management
- Augmented blended learning in teaching was implemented.
- Integrated programs on experimental basis in consideration with NEP 2020. For example B.Sc. (Multimedia & Animation), B.A. (Mass Communication) and a few departments of B.Com. and B.Sc. will start from 2023-24.
- Students' papers were published into ISBN Books.
- Networking, collaborating and interacting with local, national and foreign Universities has begun.
- A Green Audit, Energy Audit, Environmental Audit, and Gender Audit are in process.
- Acquiring ISO certification (national and international) is in process.
- Formulating strategic plans inviting applications from National / International students and sports students for admission into the College is in process.
- Conducting Certificate and Competitive exams coaching in the campus for students by collecting a nominal fee was implemented.
- Reformulating the vision and mission of the college in view of upgrading Loyola Academy to Loyola University is in discussion.
- An ICC (Internal Complaints Committee) was constituted.
