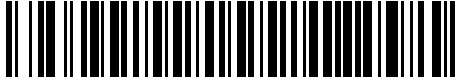

The main purpose of this Advisory is to make you aware that the National Testing Agency aims to conduct fair and transparent examinations so that deserving candidates only get the right admissions or jobs. - We focus on cheating in the form of seeking outside help during the exam and catch hold on this by implying various technologies/tools. The examination centres are continuously being monitored through artificial-enabled systems.
