Independence Day

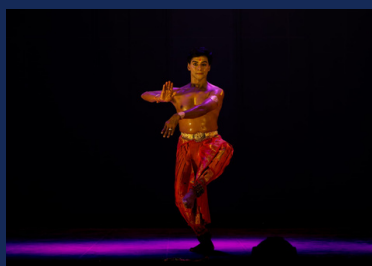
15-08-2023

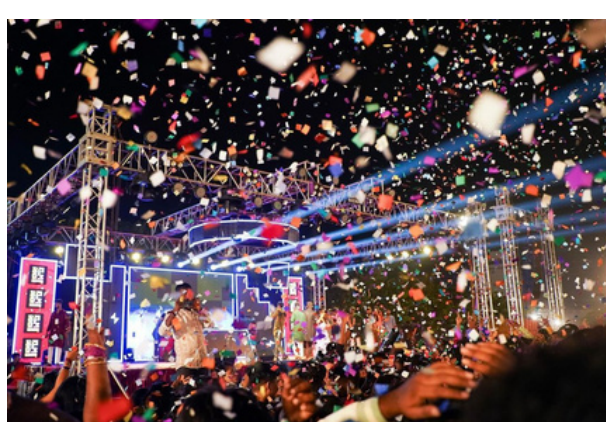


COLLEGE DAY 07-03-2023
