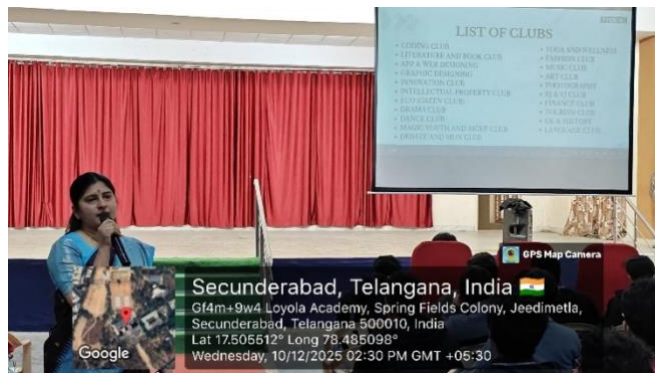

### **Activities Conducted by the Club:**

1. Basics of Photography: Students learned camera handling and the exposure triangle (aperture, shutter speed, ISO). Mini photo challenge: "*Blur vs Sharp.*"
2. Composition Games: Focused on rule of thirds, framing, and symmetry. Activity: Students recreated a famous photograph using classmates as subjects.
3. Lighting Introduction: Differentiating between natural and artificial light. Quick activity: One subject photographed in three different lighting conditions.
4. Portrait Photography (Basics): Students practiced expressions, posing, and framing through paired portrait sessions.
5. Photography Challenge: Theme – "*Life Between Classes.*" Students captured candid campus moments reflecting everyday college life.
6. Peer Critique Sessions: Each student presented three photos and received constructive feedback from classmates.
7. Speed Shooting: Students were given 10 minutes to shoot five photos on a specific theme, encouraging creativity under time constraints.
8. Mystery Shoot: Students received random on-the-spot themes (e.g., "*Isolation,*" "*Hope,*" "*Chaos*") and 30 minutes to capture three photos based on interpretation.
9. One-on-One Shoot (Portrait Battle): Two students photographed the same subject, and peers critiqued whose image told a stronger story.

10. Black & White vs Color Shoot: Students shot the same subject in both black & white and color, comparing the visual impact of each.
11. Editing Techniques: Students explored editing software to perform basic adjustments such as cropping, exposure correction, and sharpening using RAW photos.
12. Color Correction: Members practiced color correction by editing one photo into three distinct moods—natural, warm, and dramatic.
13. Digital Storage: Students learned proper digital organization techniques—creating folder structures, renaming files, and backing them up to cloud or external storage.
14. Editing Relay: A fun collaborative exercise where one student edited a photo for three minutes before passing it on. After five rounds, the final version was compared to the original.
15. Digital Slideshow Screening: All members' best works were compiled into a slideshow with music and captions, screened for the club to celebrate creativity and progress.

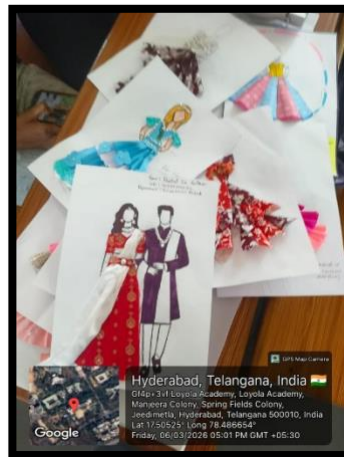

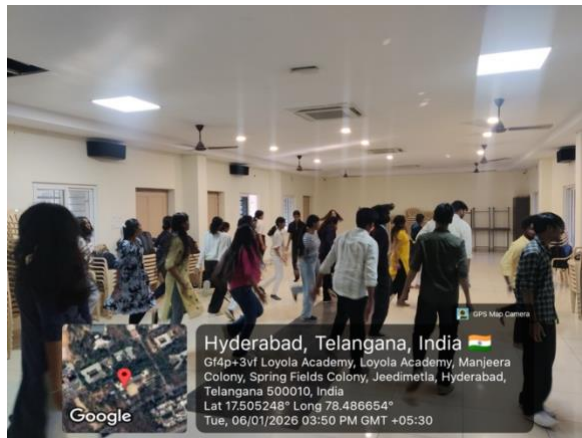

### **Activities Conducted**
